

Step 6 – Accreditation Visit

An ASF accreditor will be appointed to schools once their application is approved by the ASF screening committee.

The accreditor will contact the school by phone and agree a date for the accreditation visit to take place within the following two weeks.

The purpose of the accreditor's visit is to:

- Acknowledge the efforts of the school and all those who contributed to the ASF process.
- View the evidence that verifies that the improvements stated on the application form have been implemented.
- Advise the school about current physical activity promoting initiatives that are available and to suggest ways that the school might further develop in the future.

PE, physical activity and sports provision should be visibly improved as a result of the school's participation in the Active School Flag initiative.
