

Step 2 – Establish Active School Flag Committee

Each school should appoint an Active School Flag coordinator to lead the school through the Active School Flag process.

The next step should be to establish an Active School Flag committee. This will act as the working group for the school community. Nominees from all areas of the school community should be invited to form part of the ASF committee – pupils, teachers, non-teaching staff members, management, parents and members of the community. It is essential that the Active School Flag committee has the support of the school principal.

Applying for the Active School Flag should be a whole school effort. Schools are encouraged to look for internal support within the school community whilst also seeking the assistance of outside agencies such as Local Sports Partnerships, National Governing Bodies and the HSE.
